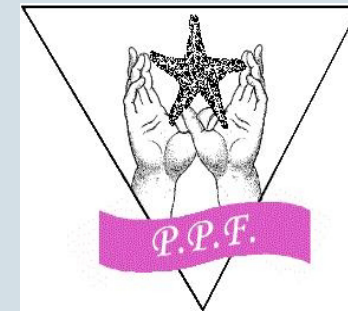

Rachel's Story

Rachel Dombroski is an 18 year old, young woman. Four years ago, on November 25, 2006 she was in an automobile accident, which involved a drunk driver. Rachel is now a quadriplegic, mute, as a result of a

Traumatic Brain Injury. It has been a long struggle/process that has impacted and changed her life as well as her family. We work hard to give Rachel as normal a life as possible, taking her everywhere we go. Every outing is a struggle as we navigate a world with limited accessibility for wheelchairs. However, without a van to transport Rachel life can be very isolating. We have gone through two wheel chair accessible vans in the past three years. Neither of the vans had air conditioning or all the safe traveling equipped items. This new van project will be a blessing to our family and will help keep Rachel in the mainstream with her peers.
